Mr. Christopher Michael Cheramie and Mr. Rodney Reece Thompson, Jr. were legally married in a private ceremony on Sunday, June 28, 2015 at 3:00 in the afternoon, in their Historic Belmont Avenue District home. The Honorable F. Lee Russell, Circuit Court Judge , Tennessee 17th District, officiated over the couples nuptials which were witnessed by their mothers, Mrs. Jeanette Cheramie and Mrs. Mary Ann Thompson-Anderson.

Mr. Cheramie, originally of New Orleans, Louisiana is the son of the late Mr. Lynn James Cheramie, II and Mrs. Jeanette Ballard-Cheramie currently a resident of Hermitage, Tennessee. He is the grandson of the late Mr. & Mrs. Lynn James Cheramie, Sr. and the late Mr. & Mrs. William Ballard.

Mr. Thompson, originally of Huntsville, Alabama is the only son of the late Mr. Rodney R Thompson, Sr. and Mrs. Mary Ann Thompson-Anderson currently a resident of Shelbyville, Tennessee. He is the grandson of the late Mr. & Mrs. M. Reese Thompson and the late Mr. & Mrs. Louis W. Mills.
